

## JOB DESCRIPTION

#### Cropping Manager - FNQ

We are seeking a passionate, responsible, enthusiastic and "hands-on" cropping manager to work closely with the General Manager/FNQ Manager and relevant management personnel in both locations. This challenging role requires outstanding communication skills and a flexible approach to manage a wide range of tasks relating to a diverse business, where there is reward for high achievement.

As Cropping Manager you would be responsible for growing all crops (zucchini, pumpkins, tomatoes, sweetcorn, onions and other trial crops) from ground preparation through to produce dispatch. As a team leader you will be mentored by the General Manager to assist with the day to day running while keeping a close eye on efficiency, effectiveness of decisions and work carried out. Confidence and decisiveness will be an asset as you will be required to make quick decisions at a moment's notice.

This position will require training on the job with external training as required. There is potential for growth within the company with larger volumes or different types of crops depending on what markets can be accessed.





### DUTIES

#### Cropping Manager - FNQ

- Working closely with the General Manager/FNQ Manager
- Assisting with the day to day management including but not exclusive to: machinery maintenance, planning, ground preparation, fertilising, planting, irrigation, crop maintenance and logistics, harvest and packing, produce dispatch and transport
- Gain an understanding of Organic and Freshcare Certification requirements. Perform duties in accordance with these standards and guidelines
- Complete all required documentation for HR, dispatch and certification records as required
- Train staff in OHS, harvesting, weeding, packing and other training as required (including multi-lingual seasonal workers)
- Obtain and/or maintain Forklift and HR licence
- Tractor work as required
- Maintenance on irrigation system as required
- Have a working knowledge of computer systems
- Assist in R&D activities as required


